

The New Strategic Arms Limitation Treaty will expire in May 2021, and the United States, which has withdrawn from the agreement, keeps talking and considering refusing to extend it on the grounds that China does not join the relevant treaties. Russia welcomes China's accession to the new nuclear arms control treaty, but it is not enthusiastic to press China at the request of the United States. China has participated in a large number of important international organizations and conventions that form the basis of the modern international political and economic structure. The China Guide agreement and the New Strategic Arms Limitation Treaty are the most important international conventions in the modern international security structure. Should China join? China will certainly not join because of US pressure. Whether China joins or not can only be determined by China's security interests. In principle, nuclear disarmament is in the interests of both the world and China. But nuclear disarmament is not an average shaving, it must be fair and reasonable. When the United States asks China to participate in nuclear arms control, it first raises the question of "whether to lower the U.S. nuclear arms to the level of China or to raise the Chinese nuclear arms to the level of the United States". This is a reasonable question, but it is also doomed to be unanswered. It is impossible for the United States to reduce its nuclear armament to the level of China, and China is not interested in raising it to the level of the United States.
