The British government announced the design of a new passport on the 22nd in a proud atmosphere after brexit, the US website quartz reported Thursday. In the middle of the passport is the British crest, with the words "British passport" on it and "United Kingdom of Great Britain and Northern Ireland" below. The appearance of the passport is dark blue, the same as before it joined the European Community (the predecessor of the European Union) in 1988. Before brexit, the British used a red burgundy passport. The new blue passport will be in use in March.
