

Liu He, vice premier of the State Council and China's leader of the China US comprehensive economic dialogue, spoke to us trade representative Laith Heze and finance minister nuqin at an appointment in the morning, Xinhua reported Friday. The two sides said they should strengthen cooperation in macro-economy and public health, create favorable atmosphere and conditions for the implementation of the first phase of the China US economic and trade agreement, and promote positive results.

The two sides agreed to maintain communication and coordination, the report said.

President trump said Wednesday he will be able to report in about a week or two whether China is meeting its obligations under the first phase of the trade agreement. China and the United States signed the first phase of the trade agreement before the global spread of the new coronavirus in January this year.
